## Course Outline

### Math:

Units this year will follow a sequential development of skill. Each term will cover outcomes from the units of Patterns and Relationships, Basic Operations, Measurement, Data Management, Statistics and Probability, and Geometry. Focus will be on problem solving skills and strategies. The outcomes for the province have been adapted to reflect both age appropriate development and reasonable and attainable outcomes expectations. I will be following the provincial timeline for grade 4. I will send home a long-range plan for you. Please note that integration of other subjects will be included to support mathematical thinking and real life application of skill. Our goal is to strengthen the mathematical foundation for the students, especially in patterning and number sense.

### Language Arts:

Language Arts will be a balanced approach that focuses daily on reading, writing, reflecting, and speaking. Focus this year will be on further developing reading, writing, and speaking skills with a focus on detail, voice, presentation and clear expression. As well as developing their written work of various genres. Whenever appropriate, integration of Science, Social, Health, and Art will occur to allow for a deeper skill development, problem solving, inquiry thinking, and a deeper level of learning. Through the explorations of relevant and high interest topics, communication whether written or oral is supported. Our goal is to support language development through relevant experiences and strong foundation of literacy skills.

## Integrated Studies

Science: Integration of units on rocks/minerals/erosion, habitats, and energy units on light and sound.

Social Studies: Integration of units on exploration, nature of exploration, exploring our world, exploring the landscapes of Canada will be covered. There will also be a strong focus in all daily lessons on exploring and celebrating our diverse cultures of both Nova Scotia and Canada.

Health: Students will focus on self-regulation, positive choices and actions, understanding how the brain works in relation to our thoughts, emotions. Focus units on relationships, gender identity and roles, human development (including sexual development), healthy living choices, addictions, injury prevention, self-care, active living and transportation, and supporting mental health and self-image. This will be supported using the PATHS and Minds Up Programs.

Art: Students will participate in an integrated approach to exploring various artists and their work and focusing on personal art making using a variety of art mediums. They will learn to compare, interpret, create, and reflect.
